## Security/Safety Reminder

Most likely you have seen us installing the swipe system on all the doors in each facility. Each employee will receive an individual proxy card with their employee number on it. All doors will remain locked and a proxy card will be the only way to gain entry.

The Company recognizes our responsibility to provide our employees and visitors a safe environment where you and your possessions are offered protection.

To ensure the environment is kept safe, the Company has made the decision to implement a proxy card swipe system throughout all three plants. The principle objective is to prevent unwanted people from entering the building.

## Government Support – COVID-19

1. All major Canadian banks are offering mortgage deferral programs
2. You can defer Income Tax Payments, both final payments and instalment payments that were originally due March 16<sup>th</sup>, to September 1<sup>st</sup> [CRA's COVID-19 page](#)
3. An increase in GST credit of \$400 per individual and \$600 per couple, payment to be made in early May
4. Increase in Canada Child Tax Benefit \$300 per child
5. One-time payment of \$200 per child up to 12 years of age and \$250 for those with special needs, including children enrolled in private schools to help with the extra costs due to closure of schools
6. The Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) loan repayment and interest accrual temporarily suspended between March 30<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
